The decisions taken in the meeting were taken into consideration for improving the quality of the institute. The feedback was taken from the stakeholders.. Dr. A. T. Shinde joined as a Principal in the college on 10th February, 2025. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) prepared an academic calendar of the college and looked after the activities to be conducted in the college. The various departments and the committees formed in the college carried out different activities for maintaining quality in the institute. The college is recognized under section 2 (f) of the UGC Act,1956.


on the theme of Youth for My Bharat and Youth for Digital Literacy was organised at Dongargaon from 2nd January to 8th January, 2025.
