



IQAC Annual Report 2017-2018

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) held three meetings in the academic year 2017-18. In the meetings, the plans and suggestions were discussed and implemented for quality enhancement measures. The feedback opinions were taken from the students. These feedbacks were Teacher Evaluation by students, course Evaluation and parents' feedback. These activities helped college authorities to modify and improve the facilities in the college.

On behalf of the National Service Scheme Department of the college, the birth anniversary of Vasantrao Naik, the father of green revolution, was celebrated. A tree plantation programme was celebrated in the college. Marathwada Liberation Day and University Foundation Day was celebrated in the college on 1 July, 2017 in the same manner in which Independence Day and Republic Day are celebrated. The flag was hoisted on this occasion at the hands of In-charge principal Dr. L. T. Kale on 17. 09.2017. Rajshri Shahu Maharaj's birth anniversary was celebrated as Social Justice Day.

A special Camp on Youth and Clean India for the Conservation of Environment and Natural Resources was held by the NSS department of Rajiv Gandhi Mahavidyalaya, Mudkhed at Kolha from 26. 12. 2017 to 01.01. 2018. 
