

IOAC Annual Report 2021-2022

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) tries to improve the quality of the college. It functions on the basis of the guidelines framed by NAAC. The committee held three meetings in the academic year 2020-21. In the meetings, the plans and suggestions were discussed and implemented for quality enhancement measures. The recommendations of the IQAC and the stakeholders were taken into consideration to carry out the perspective plans of the institute.

The feedback opinions were taken from the students. These feedbacks were Teacher Evaluation by students, Course Evaluation, Evaluation of Library and Administration by Students, Alumni Feedback and Parents' Feedback. These activities helped college authorities to modify and improve the facilities in the college.

The software of E-granthalaya was updated in the library. New books were purchased in the college library. The Wi-Fi facility was made available in the five classrooms. The Smart Interactive Board was also made available in the college. The LCD projectors were also installed in the college. The equipment related to the laboratory was purchased. The Sports facilities were also made available for the students in the college.

Rajiv Gandhi Mahavidyalaya's Competitive Exam Cell tries to prepare students to face competitive exams. Prashant Venkatrao Patil, CEO, Mudkhed Council, was invited to guide the students at 1 on August 24, 2021. 


