The Internal Quality Assurance Cell attempts to improve the quality of the college. The IQAC held 4 meetings in the academic year 2023- 24. The decisions taken in the meeting were taken into consideration for improving the quality of the institute. The feedback taken from the stakeholders also helped for taking the decisions. The different committees were formed for the smooth functioning of the college.

The department of Marathi conducted wall -poster publication program (Dnyanteerth) on 2 August, 2022. The students of Marathi department participated in this activity. The wall posters prepared by the students were based on Marathi short story writers. It also took some activities on the occasion of Marathi fortnight.

Hindi department of Rajiv Gandhi Mahavidyalaya conducted a guest lecture of Prakash Shinde, associate professor, Pansare Mahavidyalaya, Arjapur on *Literature and Nature* on 30th September, 2023.
